#### **RCMS #187 - Thursday, September 3, 2015**

- NYISO July 24, 2015 letter regarding Non-Compliance Assessment with Reliability Rule I.4 (R3) - Transmission Data
  - RCMS preparing draft report of its "preliminary non-compliance finding" based upon the following factors
    - Impossibility of perfect accuracy based upon the thousands of data items and repetitive updating of data sets with the implication that all Market Participants could be continuously found in non-compliance
    - While all data errors require correction, most do not adversely affect reliability and judgment is required to assess materiality
    - Recognition of NYISO's and Market Participant data checking procedures
    - Recognition of mitigation steps already taken
    - Recognition of the opportunity to clarify Reliability Rule I.4 (R3) and NYISO procedures
  - RCMS Report will be presented to EC following RCMS discussion & recommendation
