Dear Ms. Bose:

On April 12, 2012, the New York State Reliability Council, L.L.C. ("NYSRC") filed comments in response to TC Ravenswood, L.L.C.'s ("TCR") March 30, 2012 rate schedule proposing to sell black start service pursuant to Section 205 of the Federal Power Act. Included with our comments, was a copy of the final report by NYSRC's Reliability Compliance Monitoring Subcommittee ("RCMS") titled Evaluation of the New York Control Area Black Start Program. We also informed the Commission that the RCMS report had been submitted to the NYSRC's Executive Committee, which would make the final determination as to whether the report's findings and recommendations should be adopted. This letter is to inform the Commission that at its meeting on April 13, 2012, the NYSRC Executive Committee approved the findings and conclusions in the RCMS report and accepted the report's recommendation that the NYSRC notify certain parties, including the Commission, of its concern for the 2012 Summer Capability period, in view of the TC Ravenswood's position that it has effectively withdrawn from participation in the NYISO's system restoration program.
