7. Section B – Requirements	
Requirements	R2. The NYISO shall maintain procedures and systems that ensure that appropriate actions are taken when thermal, voltage, and/or stability limits are exceeded. <u>These procedures shall identify System Operating States that warrant the NYISO to invoke ETC.</u> The NYISO must notify the NYSRC of any changes to these procedures and systems.
8. Section C – Compliance Elements	
1. Measures	The NYISO maintained procedures and systems in accordance with R1 and R2 which identify appropriate actions to be taken whenever the bulk power transmission system's thermal, voltage, and <i>stability limits</i> are exceeded. <u>The procedures identified System Operating States that warrant the NYISO to invoke ETC.</u> Any revisions to these procedures or systems were reported to the NYSRC.
