6. Measurement(s)	C-M5: Owners of resources located in or serving the NYCA shall provide to the NYISO accurate resource outage and load response data on a timely basis for their units in accordance with NYISO procedures, tariffs and schedules (see Measurement C-M4)

7. Full Compliance Statement	The NYISO certifies that all Installed Capacity Providers have accurately reported outage and load response data on schedule in accordance with applicable NYISO procedures, tariffs and schedules, and with Measurement C-M5.
8. Levels of Non-Compliance	
Level 1	Not applicable.
Level 2	The NYISO certified that audits or other investigations found that outage and load response data reports from one or more Installed Capacity Providers were in non-compliance with NYISO procedures and schedules.
Level 3	The NYISO found that reports from one or more Installed Capacity Providers were in non-compliance with NYISO procedures and schedules (see Level 2), and in addition, the NYISO did not apply appropriate sanctions or letters for non-compliance with NYISO outage reporting requirements for one or more Installed Capacity Providers, as required by the NYISO

	Market Services Tariff.
Level 4	One or more Installed Capacity Providers failed to submit an outage data report to the NYISO as required by NYISO procedures and schedules.
