## NYSRC POLICY ON NERC STANDARD BALLOTING

Balloting Responsibility: NYSRC Representative on the NERC Ballot Body (RBB)

- 1. The RBB shall regularly check for NERC notices on planned NERC standard balloting.
- 2. The RBB shall <u>promptly</u> transmit, via e-mail, a notice of planned NERC balloting to EC and RRS members. The notice will include the standard or group of standards to be balloted and a request to recommend an affirmative or negative balloting position or an <u>abstention</u>. The notice shall include the date by which the member's balloting recommendation(s) must be transmitted to the RBB. The notice may also include a suggested voting position or other information concerning the standards to be balloted, including NPCC comments. For negative voting recommendations, the members must provide a statement as to why the proposed standard changes should not be approved. (The RBB must include such a statement when casting a negative vote.) Without such a statement, the member's negative voting position will not be counted.

## 3. RBB Voting

- a. After receiving <u>timely</u> balloting positions from <u>EC and RRS NYSRC</u> members, the RBB shall cast an affirmative or negative vote on the balloted standard or standards based on the majority positions of voting positions received. If there is a tie, the RBB shall abstain. <u>If no voting positions are received, the RBB is free to vote based on his or her own judgement or to abstain.</u>
- b. As an exception, the EC may vote to override the above voting position based upon input from RRS and/or the EC's independent consideration. Such action will be dependent upon time constraints imposed by NERC's balloting schedule and EC/RRS schedules.
