RESOURCE ADEQUACY ADVISORY WORKING GROUP WORK SCOPE

<u>Purpose</u>

The Resource Adequacy Advisory Working Group (RAAWG) monitors and reviews relevant probabilistic assessments and technical papers on resource adequacy by the NYISO and other electric power industry entities; and advises the Executive Committee and subcommittees, when appropriate, on issues regarding resource adequacy. The RAAWG adheres to all policies and procedures established by the Executive Committee and its meetings are open to all interested parties who wish to attend.

Responsibilities

- 1. Review NYISO Reliability Needs Analyses (RNA), NYISO Comprehensive Reliability Plan (CRP), Installed Reserve Margin (IRM) reports, and other publications relative to resource adequacy; and prepare summaries on key reliability issues of interest to the NYSRC from these publications.
- 2. When requested by RCMS, provide advice relevant to the Working Group's review of the NYISO's RNA and CRP reports.
- 3. Periodically review industry and academic publications and technical papers covering resource adequacy and reliability metric issues -- from NERC, NPCC, and other sources -- and note those issues that may of relevance to the NYSRC.
- 4. Prepare recommendations to the Executive Committee relative to resource adequacy applications and related reliability metrics and resource adequacy criteria.
- 5. Request ICS or the NYISO to conduct special reliability analyzes, if needed, to support resource adequacy application recommendations.
- 6. Prepare and submit reports requested by the Executive Committee.
- 7. Brief ICS as necessary on RAAWG matters.

Reporting

The RAAWG reports to the NYSRC Executive Committee.

RAAWG Membership

RAAWG members are appointed by the Executive Committee chair, and initially includes two representatives from the Executive Committee; one representative from ICS; one representative from RRS; and two non-voting participants, one from NYISO staff and one NYSRC consultant. The Executive Committee representatives will serve as RAAWG chair and vice chair, respectively.

Approval Process

The RAAWG seeks to achieve a consensus on its actions and recommendations.

Meeting Frequency

The RAAWG meets at the RAAWG chair's discretion.
