4.1.3 2023 IRM Draft Study Report – Attachment #4.1.3 – EC Approval Item

At the December 1st ICS meeting #271, the ICS reviewed and approved the updated IRM Study Report for 2023 along with the Appendices document. There were no Special Sensitivities to consider this year.

In November, during TO QA/QC review of the Final Base Case a consequential error was found within the model data regarding a cable connection to Long Island which resulted in incorrect treatment of the cable within the model. The error occurred in implementation of the updated UDR election for the Cross Sound Cable ("CSC"), in the transfer limits that facilitate the flow of the UDR MW. Correcting the error increases the availability of the UDR MW, improving the overall system reliability and hence reducing ICAP requirements to meet 0.1 LOLE criteria.

As a result, after correcting the error, new Tan-45 analyses were run to determine the statewide IRM and LCRs. This resulted in a final statewide IRM of 19.9% versus the 20.2% that was erroneously calculated. The Locational Capacity results also decreased: the Zone J LCR from 78.4% to 78.2% and the Zone K LCR from 108.0% to 107.4%.

The ICS accepted/approved the updated results and recommends that the EC adopt the new Final Base Case for the 2023 IRM Study.
