#### A.3: Review of Resource Adequacy

### NYSRC Requirement(s) for which compliance is being self-certified

R.1 An *NYCA resource adequacy* assessment shall be conducted annually for the next summer period and two years beyond, for demonstrating that proposed *NYCA resources* meet *NYCA statewide IRM* and *New York City and Long Island locational capacity requirements* as determined by *NYSRC* and *NYISO* studies conducted in accordance with A.1 and A.2. The assessment shall be documented in a *resource adequacy* report, covering at a minimum, the evaluations and information below:

R1.1 The assessment shall evaluate a base case assuming proposed *resources* and the most likely *load* forecast, as well as alternate scenarios approved by RCMS.

R1.2 Any potential base case *resource adequacy* needs shall be addressed by *NYISO* procedures. The *NYISO* shall report to the *NYSRC* on identified needs and possible corrective actions consistent with *NYISO* procedures

R1.3 The *resource adequacy* report shall include key assumptions and other factors considered in the assessment.
