“Con Ed Procedure SO03-26-10 SYSTEM OPERATIONS REQUIREMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH NYISO DAY AHEAD UNIT COMMITMENT AND GENERATION DISPATCH” addresses G.1 R1, the need to operate to second contingency.

“Con Ed Procedure SO05-02-19 THUNDERSTORM\_STORM PROCEDURE” addresses G.1 R2, the need for TSA.

“Con Ed Procedure SO03-26-10 SYSTEM OPERATIONS REQUIREMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH NYISO DAY AHEAD UNIT COMMITMENT AND GENERATION DISPATCH” addresses G.1 R3, the need to operate to maintain in-city levels of reserve.

“Con Ed Procedure SO05-02-19 THUNDERSTORM\_STORM PROCEDURE” addresses G.1 R4, the implementation of TSA.

Each of the procedures contains numerous requirements for NYISO notification and consent for the actions noted.

Ref 2 - Con Ed Procedure SO05-02-19 THUNDERSTORM\_STORM PROCEDURE addresses G.1 R2 & R4 the need for TSA.

Ref 3 - Con Ed Procedure SO03-26-10 SYSTEM OPERATIONS REQUIREMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH NYISO DAY AHEAD UNIT COMMITMENT AND GENERATION DISPATCH addresses G.1 R3, the need to operate to maintain in-city levels of reserve.
